

SLNC Tackles Potholes

SLNC Board Member Barbara Ringuette recently toured Silver Lake with the City of Los Angeles Bureau of Street Services to identify streets and sidewalks in the community that need small repairs. Based on reports from residents and Ringuette's street survey, the Bureau completed repairs on Hyperion Avenue, Sunset Boulevard, Silver Lake Boulevard, Coronado Street and Rampart Boulevard. Additional repairs will be done on Griffith Park Boulevard. The Bureau's Neighborhood Council Initiative program sends out a small asphalt truck twice a year to fill potholes and fix sidewalks.

When you see a dangerous situation on a city sidewalk or hit a pothole, email the Transportation and Public Works Committee at Transportation@silverlakenc.org and they will add your request to an ongoing list of locations that need repairs during the next cycle. Ringuette stated that SLNC wants to keep up with these improvements to enhance safety for our residents and avoid damage to autos and bicycles.
