

# SLNC Funds Homeless Outreach Grant, Reinstates Adopt-A-Stair Program

At the March 1 Governing Board meeting, the Silver Lake Neighborhood Council voted to approve a \$1500 Neighborhood Purpose Grant (NPG) to People Assisting the Homeless ([PATH](#)). SLNC Homelessness in Silver Lake Co-chair Darius Derakshan noted the funds would be used to support PATH's outreach programs to homeless people in Silver Lake.

The Board also approved a motion from the Green Committee to reinstate the Silver Lake Adopt-A-Stair Program, which will preserve, protect and enhance a community treasure. The program allows residents to oversee the maintenance of a stairway and will be managed by the Green Committee and the Silver Lake Improvement Association. There are 52 stairways in Silver Lake and 28 have been adopted, leaving 24 eligible for adoption.

In separate actions, the Board supported a Conditional Use Permit for the onsite sale of beer and wine at Trois Familia, 3510 Sunset Boulevard, and a motion to continue the energy created at the recent SLNC Vision & Goals meeting by connecting attendees to committees that address their areas of interest. The Board also approved funding in the amount of \$500 to support The Taste of the Eastside event on April 30 and several amendments to SLNC bylaws, which will be detailed at a later date.
