### 4. Motions and Resolutions

- **MOTION:** Maker moves that the SLNC approves spending \$1500 to support the Silver Lake Picture Show's screening of "A League of Their Own" 2017 summer session. The committee will invite dignified speakers, LA area women who were instrumental in the breaking of barriers to sports participation. In addition, the screening will serve as a fundraiser for the Parks Dept "Girls play" program. **Terry Jackson** asks what the \$500 will pay for.
- Patty and Heather discuss potential guest speakers and status as to availability. Patty has a contact she is working on.
- Patty discusses the Girls Play program and has made contact with Parks and Rec regarding support.
- Stephanie wonders if chairs can be provided. Nick will work on that.
- Stephanie seconded the motion, Nick moved.
- Vote is held – unanimous.
- **MOTION:** Maker moved that the SLNC approve spending \$2500 to help the AT Center become ADA compliant so that they are able to serve a more diverse population.

- Korey provided bid copies amounting to over 12k to make the entire center ADA compliant.
- Korey and Patty discuss upcoming meeting with CD 13 to pursue additional funds.
- Korey is finding out if the contactor is “ADA Certified”.
- Seed money would be used to start the process of ADA compliance with the simplest fix first allowing full access on the top floor.
- Motion is seconded by Nick, moved by Korey.
- Motion passes unanimously.
  - Discussion and possible action:** Progress of CERT training signups, supplies, next steps.
- Patty says that Ivanhoe has been publicizing the training and it is about half way full.
- Patty will pick up training kits which have been ordered and paid for for approximately half attendees per motion. The kits are held inside of a safety helmet for easy identification.
- Korey asks about next steps for community watch groups and grids.
- Patty says next step will be another phase with LAFD program to find out how to let neighbors know who is CERT trained.

- Nick suggests “secretstairsofsilverlake”, an existing hashtag.
- Stephanie suggests “LAWalks” and that we work with that group who will also have a booth at the fair.
- Patty asks if there is a way our booths can be near LFNC and LA Walks.
- Patty also wants “Itookthestairs”.
