The proposed program fails to pay sufficient respect to neighboring residential or commercial uses. We believe the proposed program must include advance notification to neighbors within 500 feet and to neighborhood councils, require a public hearing, and an appeals process.

The draft programproposal allows no opportunity for public input before a clearance is granted. The program would eliminate the opportunity for site-specific, operation-specific or neighborhood-specific
