Wording of Motion 5A

*To the Los Angeles City Council,*

*In March of 2017, nearly 70% of LA County residents approved funding for homelessness services by voting in favor of Measure H this spring.*

*With the passage of Measure H, voters believed they were generating new funds to be directed toward the services that help lift people out of homelessness – services such as outreach teams of case workers and health specialists; the development of bridge housing and rapid rehousing; and services such as job training, substance abuse counseling and mental health treatment for residents experiencing homelessness.*

*Although we appreciate Los Angeles Police Department’s role is protecting our homeless community members nowhere in the Measure H calls for funding law enforcement. We believe that transferring any of the funds the City of Los Angeles receives from the measure to LAPD would not be following the wishes of the voters.*

*We ask that Measure H funding only go toward the services and programs voters intended for, and not to increased policing.*
